Decision Making and Problem Solving

Workshop Overview

A significant factor in sustaining peak performance is the collective ability of the managers to effectively address problems and make decisions. In *Decision Making and Problem Solving* we start out by giving managers a process for identifying which of all their urgent decisions and problems are the most critical to organizational performance. We give managers a process for addressing problems and making decisions that leads to the highest value contribution to the company. We call this process value-based decision making. During the workshop managers apply the tools presented in the workshop to their real-time job situations. We also show managers how to generate enrollment and support for implementing a decision after it has been made.

Workshop Objectives

1. Managers understand the importance of consistently using a process for identifying and prioritizing the most important and urgent problems and decisions they face.
2. Managers follow the decision making process presented in the workshop to arrive at an effective, high value decision or resolution to a problem.
3. Managers generate enrollment and support for their decisions.

Take-Home Value for Managers and their Company

1. Managers become more valuable decision makers and problem solvers.
2. Decisions and problem resolutions are implemented more effectively.
3. The most important problems in the company receive the greatest attention, and their solutions generate the highest value for the company.
